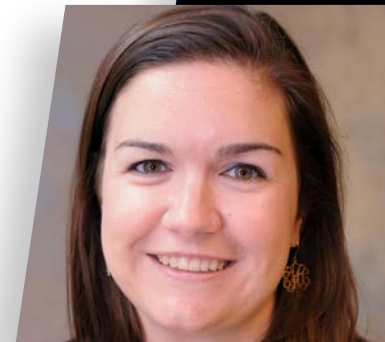

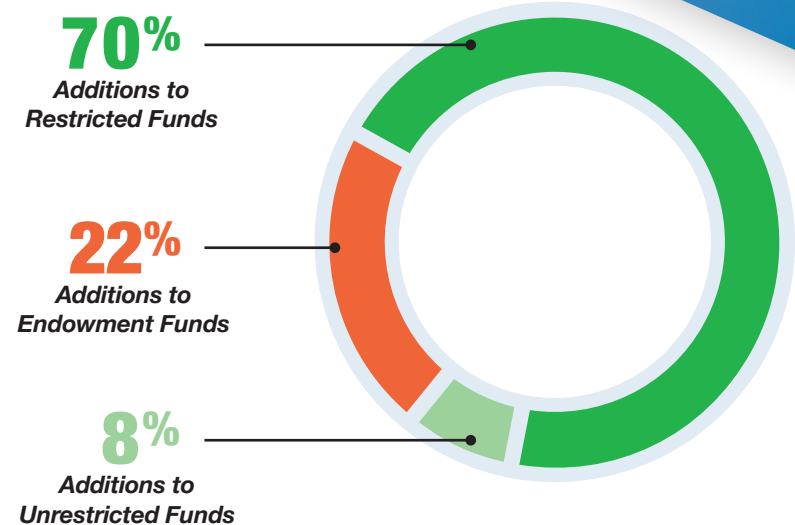
FINANCIAL REPORT

The community continued its investment in the Central Carolina Community College Foundation through the donation of \$842,716.95 during the 2017 – 2018 fiscal year.

In-kind gifts of equipment, supplies, pro bono, and other services totaling \$70,108.34 were also donated to the college.

During the 2017 – 2018 fiscal year, the CCCC Foundation provided \$493,293.17 in support of the college and to the students it serves.

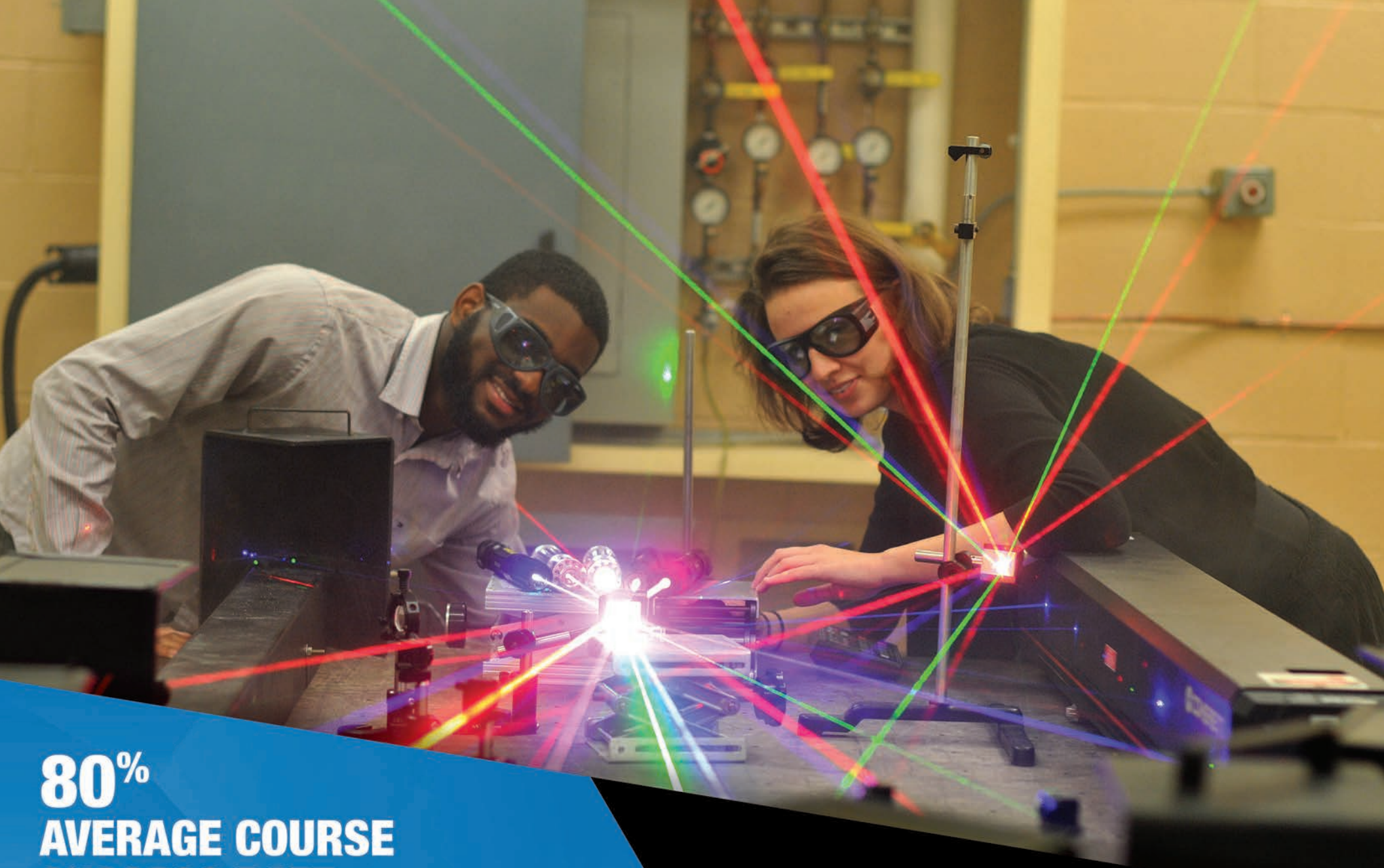
