NCLive Week--June 2-8

North Carolina Libraries for Virtual Education (NC LIVE) is a collection of databases that give the citizens of North Carolina online access to complete articles from over 5,500 newspapers, journals, magazines, and encyclopedias, indexing for over 15,000 periodical titles, and access to over 13,000 electronic books. NCLive is available free of charge for CCCC library patrons and can be accessed from any computer on campus or from home with a password. Please ask at circulation desk for information.

Recent additions to the databases:

The Scribner Writers Series includes 1,564 essays on authors of all nationalities and time periods. Each essay includes a concise introductory preface and a biography placing the author's work within a personal and historical framework.

North American Women's Letters and Diaries contains approximately 150,000 pages of published letters and diaries plus 4,000 pages of previously unpublished materials. Includes a comprehensive bibliography of women's diaries and letters.



New Electronic Resource

Westlaw Campus®, a complete Internet platform that lets on campus students perform legal research on Westlaw, will become available at CCCC by the beginning of summer school. Westlaw Campus lets students quickly gather background information, learn about leading cases and review governing statutes in a manner that is simple to navigate, comprehensive and on-target.

Westlaw Campus includes:

the National Reporter System, decisions and case law from the courts of all 50 states and the federal courts, plus more than a million unpublished cases;

federal regulations as published in the *Federal Register* and the *Code of Federal Regulations*;

laws from all 50 states and federal statutes, as published in the *United States Code Annotated*;

articles from law reviews and journals from a myriad of leading law schools; and

legal encyclopedias including American Jurisprudence (Am Jur) and American Law Reports (ALR)
