# You Don't Have the Book I Want--How Do I Get It?

The CCCC Library provides two different ways to get books from other libraries. The library is a member of a consortium of 44 libraries known as CCLINC (Community Colleges Libraries In North Carolina). Through the library catalog, items can be located at any or all of these libraries. To request a book from another library, you may call or come by a CCCC library or if you already have a library card, you may request the book online through the catalog. For instructions on how to do this, please call the library at 718-7244. The book will be sent to this library for you to check out. Books usually arrive within one-two weeks.

Books that are not available at a CCLINC library can also be ordered through another type of interlibrary loan. If you are unable to locate a book through CCLINC, the interlibrary loan librarian, Ellen Viggiano, will try to get the book from another library. This process requires you to have a library card, to call the library or come by and fill out a yellow interlibrary loan form. Obtaining a book by this process usually takes longer-sometimes up to a month.



### **Books for Sale**

The staff inventoried the items in the library this summer. As a result of this inventory many books are now for sale. Hardbacks cost \$1.00, paperbacks \$.50.

#### **Library Instruction**
