*Ceremony honoring graduates who "graduated with honors" as well as earliest curriculum grad, first GED grad, first adult high school grad, first graduating class, etc.*

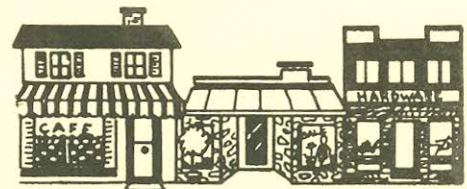
*Guest speaker. Suggestions so far include Bob Scott and Terry Sanford. Your recommendations here would be welcomed.*
