- If possible, take advantage of the Data Retrieval Tool (DRT)!!!
- Make sure that you add CCCC's school code (005449)

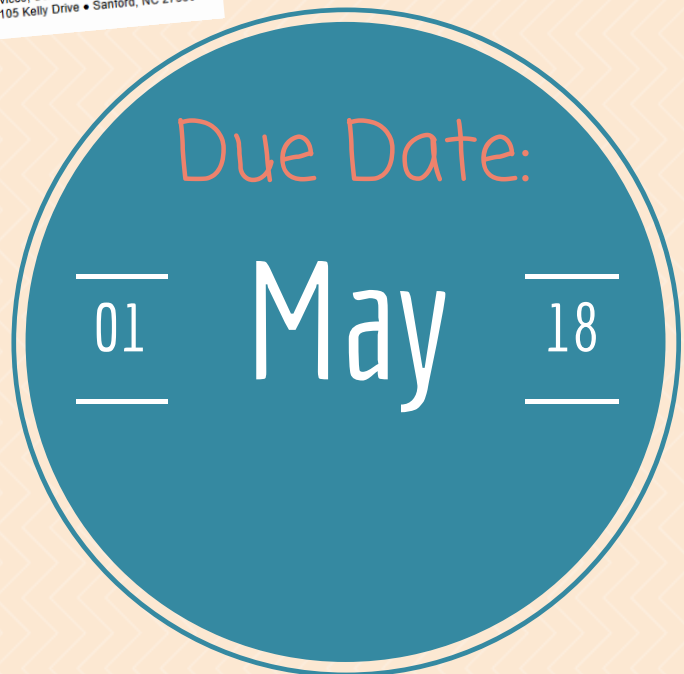
