NC LIVE sports a new look and has several new features. Beginning July 6th the **new web site** will be up and running. A tutorial to assist patrons in navigating the new site is included. Integrated searches of many databases, browsing by publication type, and subjects arranged by category are features available at the homepage. New Jobs and Business portals make collating information in these areas easy and convenient.

Academic OneFile

The library has added a **new database** called **Academic OneFile** for your research needs. **Academic OneFile** is an easy-to-use, full text general database covering the physical sciences, technology, medicine, social sciences, the arts, theology, literature and many other subjects. New Web 2.0 technologies are also incorporated to retrieve non-text formats and for sharing information. **Wilson OmniFile** will be discontinued in July.

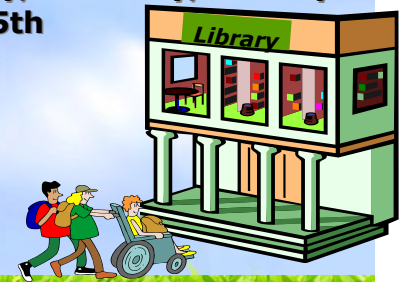
