The library has added a **new database** called **Academic OneFile** for your research needs. **Academic OneFile** is an easy-to-use, full text general database covering the physical sciences, technology, medicine, so-cial sciences, the arts, theology, literature and many other subjects. New <u>Web 2.0</u> technologies are also incorporated to re-trieve non-text formats and for sharing information. **Wilson OmniFile** will be discontinued in July.
