Winter Pathways to Success

New **HOURS** at the Harnett Library: In response to the recent library survey, the <u>Harnett Library</u> is now **open during the lunch hour,** Mondays - Fridays. Also note that the Harnett Library now **closes at 7pm,** Mondays - Thursdays.

A.D.A.M. Interactive Anatomy is a new digital database of over 20,000 anatomical images and structures with easy point and click retrieval. It is more user friendly for nursing students and general researchers than Anatomy TV, which it has replaced. It features clinical illustrations and animations, as well as 3D, dissectible, and cadaver views of the human body. A multimedia health encyclopedia is also included.

The wealth of clinical information in this multimedia database will enable students to readily understand complex anatomical structures, organs, and the body systems.



Learning Express Library in <u>NC LIVE</u> has added and/or updated several new practice tests including: GMAT (new integrated reasoning section); more NCLEX-RN tests; more Border Patrol exams; and new AP[®] Flash Reviews in Biology and US History. Adobe Illustrator CS6 (Basic & Advanced) and Adobe Photoshop CS6 (Basic & Advanced) have also been added.
