BookMyne Version 4.0 Coming Soon.

The new version of BookMyne is scheduled for release by the end of June 2013. The problems associated with downloading the app on Android devices should be resolved with the new upgrade.

Additional **Research Guides** are available now at the "Online Resources" page of the CCCC Libraries web site. The new <u>subject</u> guides include: cultures, sociology, religion, business/small business, social media, Spanish, marketing, libraries and information science, and more.

The new **Faculty Library Services** link found on the "About the Libraries" section of our web page, is a faculty resource for information on the <u>various faculty</u> <u>-specific services</u> the library offers. Overviews about library instruction, reserves, order requests, collection review, the **Films on Demand** database, plus lab and room reservations are featured. This information is especially helpful for new instructors and provides updates on new services for long term faculty.

The new **Library Services & Policies** link, found on the same web page, will benefit <u>all library patrons</u>. Check here to quickly find information about circulation, reference and instruction, computers and printing, library resources, interlibrary loans, study areas, and basic library policies. These basic library services will especially help students with study assignments and important library policies.

Líbrary Survey Results

The **library survey** taken in early April revealed some interesting results. 1) Patrons still favor print versions of book over online books. 2) The number one desired improvement requested was for one password for logging in to all the library databases. 3) More touch-screen computers in the study rooms to convert them into collaboratory study rooms was another desired improvement. 4) Harnett patrons are strongly in favor of creating a library computer lab. 5) The ability to download eBooks to mobile devices and to reserve study rooms online were also popular requests. The library will use these results in planning future resources and services. Thank you to all survey participants for your input.

The Library Standing Committee, which meets once every semester, approved new <u>library instruc-</u> <u>tion class objectives</u> for all full length library classes and allowing for selected objectives for any sessions less than 50 minutes. At the completion of Central Carolina Community College library instruction classes, students will be able to:

1. Be familiar with the availability, location, and use of materials and services offered by the CCCC libraries. (i.e. information in library brochure)

2. Locate and use information found on the CCCC library web site.

3. Identify which resources to use for their assignments. (i.e. use of research guides, library integrated search, reliable sources)

4. Perform (hands-on) a basic search in databases related to their assignments and/or course of study.

5. Refine their search using Boolean operators and/ or other limiting/expanding techniques.

6. Retrieve and use the information for their assignments. (i.e. print/download/email, evaluate search results, locate on the shelves)

7. Identify the information necessary for citing the source. (i.e. bibliographic information)

The Library Standing Committee serves as an advisory body regarding library resources, services, policies, and issues.
