Your Library Link to the World

A new password for remote access to NCLive went into effect August 15, 2003. Please ask for this password at the circulation desk of the library. Also, a major site redesign has taken place. Please come by the library for assistance in using the new interface.

You Don't Have the Book I Want--How Do I Get It?

The CCCC Library provides two different ways to get books from other libraries. The library is a member of a consortium of 44 libraries known as CCLINC (Community Colleges Libraries In North Carolina). Through the library catalog, items can be located at any or all of these libraries. To request a book from another library, you may call or come by a CCCC library or if you already have a library card, you may request the book online through the catalog. For instructions on how to do this, please call the library at 718-7244. The book will be sent to this library for you to check out. Books usually arrive within one-two weeks.

Books that are not available at a CCLINC library can also be ordered through another type of interlibrary loan. If you are unable to locate a book through CCLINC, the interlibrary loan librarian, Ellen Viggiano, will try to get the book from another library. This process requires you to have a library card, to call the library or to come by and fill out a yellow interlibrary loan form. Obtaining a book by this process usually takes longer-sometimes up to a month.



Library Instruction

During the year, a variety of instructional classes are available for students, faculty, and staff. The instructional services librarian will help determine the best class for the type and level of instruction needed. Individual instruction is available.
