# Online Help for Distance Ed Students

Check out the new Camtasiaproduced online tutorials on library skills. These are available through the College Resources 101-Library Resources page in Blackboard. These are the first of a series of online tutorials for all students, faculty, and staff. One tutorial demonstrates simple searching of the Academic Search Premier, an excellent scholarly database covering a wide range of subjects. The other tutorial on the Opposing **Viewpoints** Resource Center provides a brief overview of the source and demonstrates a basic search.

"EZ Search, still accessible from our home page, will **now offer a targeted search of 12 of our core databases**, including our largest multi-disciplinary offerings such as Academic Search Premier and Britannica Online Academic Edition. Just type in your search terms and go!

The ability to search 56 of NC LIVE's resources from a new "Advanced Search" page. This is more than a two-fold increase over our previous search capability.

Also, note that NC LIVE passwords for off campus access <u>will change</u> once a year from now on.

From now on, to place a hold for a book from another library or to check your library account simply key in the barcode on your student ID. Using the old PIN numbers is no longer necessary.

As many of you know from the previous newsletter, Mary Coleman worked at a dinosaur quarry near Grand Junction, Colorado last June.
