New Technology

New Online Tutorials are <u>available for all</u> <u>students through Blackboard</u>. They demonstrate how to use NC LIVE <u>Academic</u> <u>Search Premier, Opposing Viewpoints</u> <u>Resource Center</u>, and NC LIVE <u>NetLibrary</u> (which gives students access to 26,000+ full text eBooks). Go to College Resources 101 – in Blackboard. Open Support Services and choose Library Resources.



New copiers are in all the libraries. Printing and copying documents will now involve <u>print cards</u> that work like debit cards.

Instead of searching for change, **students** and other patrons will be able to purchase a value card for copying or printing in the library. The initial cost is \$1.00 and they can add value in increments of \$1, \$5, \$10 or \$20. When copies are made or prints are made students swipe their cards and charges are deducted after verification of the cost and number of pages.

Faculty and staff members whose regular copier is not accessible can stop by the circulation desk at the library and ask for the faculty/staff print card to make copies or print. After swiping the card, they can type

their copy code in the copier, which has been issued to them by Jan Rider. Adjunct faculty also should have received a copy code from their supervisor. The copiers work just like the other new copiers around campus.
