Instructions for Evaluation of Continuing Education Units for Curriculum Course Credit

This form is to be used when a student is requesting evaluation of continuing education credits for curriculum course credits.

- Students currently or previously enrolled in Central Carolina Community College pre-approved
 continuing education training courses may request awarded course credit in corresponding
 curriculum programs. Only courses pre-approved for articulation from continuing education to
 the curriculum sister course will be considered for conversion.
- Prior to requesting curriculum credit, the student must first register, pay, and pass the continuing education course with a grade of satisfactory.
- In order to request awarded credit, the student must be enrolled in the corresponding curriculum program and be enrolled in at least one curriculum program course past the 10% date of that semester or session.
- The student must apply for the conversion of continuing education units to curriculum credit within five (5) years of earning each applicable unit.
- Seventy-five percent (75%) of an Associate of Applied Science degree, diploma, or certificate
 may be earned with continuing education units that have been accepted as curriculum credit;
 the final twenty-five percent of any credential must be earned by completing CCCC curriculum
 education credit courses.
- Continuing education units may only be applied to specific curriculum courses and may not be used as substitutions for other required courses or courses in other programs of study.
- The credit hours of the course will count toward graduation at CCCC but may not transfer to other colleges or universities.
- The non-course credit will not be used in the student's GPA calculation.

Submit this completed form and Continuing Education transcript to the curriculum Registrar's Office.

The Continuing Education to Curriculum Awarded Credit form and the list of preapproved continuing education courses with corresponding curriculum programs is currently under development. To date, available crosswalks exist for CE Bioworks course to curriculum BPM-110 & PTC-110 courses.
