


HOW DOES ADVISING WORK AT CCCC? For Longer Term Educational Goals



New Students will:

- complete Embark Tool
- complete RDS
- apply to college
- apply for Financial Aid and Scholarships
- meet with an Education Navigator

Education Navigators will assist students with:

- Initial Onboarding to the college (ensuring RDS and application completed, transcripts received)
- Reviewing Embark results and choosing a Career Community or program
- Initial goal setting, academic planning, and first semester course registration
- Connecting to assigned faculty advisor*
- Ongoing and proactive outreach to address academic challenges and skill building
- Connection to resources and services
- Withdraws and Program Changes



Faculty Advisors will assist students with:

- Exploring career options
- Continuing goal setting
- Creating and reviewing academic plan through graduation
- Answering registration questions
- Connecting with campus
 resources
- Strategizing solutions for academic/life challenges
