New NC LIVE Interfaces



Please note the home page of NC LIVE now has new multi-media resources and interactive WEB 2.0 features.

From the homepage, patrons can find the most popular resources, browse the collection, search for eBooks, journal, or magazine articles, chat with a librarian, or read the latest blog posts and Twitter updates.

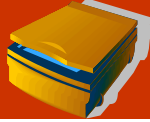
One of the biggest changes to the new site was the inclusion of special pages that draw from the entire NC LIVE collection to highlight popular research topics. From the "Browse" menu, patrons can link directly to audio or ebooks, articles or videos on particular topics such as Southern Literature, Starting a Small Business, or the Civil War.

EBSCO databases in NC LIVE will have new results pages for more intuitive refining and manipulation of those results.

New Non-NC LIVE Databases

Be sure to check out the new databases added to the online collection of databases found at the library website. They are **Academic OneFile**, which replaces Wilson OmniFile, **Anatomy TV**, **eBooks**, **Global Warming Encyclopedia**, **Psychology and Mental Health**, and **Sex and Society**. The last three listed are also available in print format at the Lee campus library.

New Equipment



All campus libraries have new **scanners** for public use. In addition, Lee library has a color printer for public use. Color printing will cost .50 per page. **Netbooks**, small laptops, are now available to students at all the libraries for in-house use.
