At Central Carolina Community College, you have many individuals who care about your success! Your advisor is someone who you will work with your entire time at CCC. Your advisor wants to ensure that you have what you need to be successful, is available to answer your questions about the college, and will help you develop an academic plan to reach your goals.



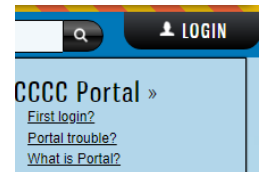
Since most advisors will be working remotely in this fall, we wanted to provide this information to help you better understand the advising experience.

Specifically, your advisor will help you....

1. **...understand college.** For many students, college is a new experience and it isn't always clear what needs to be done next! Your advisor is available whenever you have questions about more than just classes.
2. **...connect you to what you need.** We have lots of resources to support you. Your advisor can recommend resources that maybe you may have not heard of yet.
3. **...determine your academic goals** which will enable you **to build an academic plan.** It is important that we build a plan of courses unique to you that will allow you to complete your goals in a timely way.
4. **...build and maintain a connection outside of your classes.** When you and your advisor are working together, your college experience will be easier and more rewarding. You can save time, money, and avoid making errors that will prevent you from reaching your goals.

How do I contact my advisor?

- You can reach your advisor several ways. You can log into Aviso (from the black login button on the [CCCC.EDU home page](http://www.cccc.edu)), to the [CCCC Portal](http://www.cccc.edu), then click on **Aviso**, and then "Profile." You can message your advisor by clicking on their name. You can also use the Directory on the CCC.EDU home page and leave your advisor a phone message. E-mail works too!
- Your advisor may request to meet you virtually, set up a phone call, or message you through Aviso.

When should I contact my advisor?

- You can contact your advisor **WHENEVER** you have a question or concern. Your advisor may reach out to you as well. Your advisor will help with several things, including assisting you with registration for our spring semester.

Open advising begins on October 26th; registration begins on November 9th for current students and November 23rd for new students. Classes for Spring 2021 begin January 8th.
