Criminal background check, immunizations, drug testing, and supplies required before clinical rotation.

Pharmacy Technician

This course provides instruction in technical procedures for preparing and dispensing drugs under the supervision of a registered pharmacist. Emphasis is placed on drug packaging/labeling and customer service. Graduates are eligible for the Pharmacy Technician Certification Board's (PTCB), Certified Pharmacy Technician Examination (CPhT). A textbook is required. This class has campus specific enrollment requirements and textbooks.
