Electronic Notary Commission, Seal and Signature. A valid Notary Public commission number, with a valid State or Federal issued photo I.D. must be presented the first day of class as proof of qualification. A textbook is required. ### Cosmetology in Spanish I

This course allows students who speak Spanish fluently to begin working toward a certificate by gaining 422 hours of the required 1500 hours. Instruction will focus on theoretical concepts of cosmetology with hands-on experience preformed on mannequins. Students will work toward a Cosmetology License with the NC State Board of Cosmetic Arts. Perspective students must attend an orientation session, provide verification of citizenship/student visa documents, identification and take a CASAS reading assessment. A textbook, cosmetology kit and uniform are required.

This course provides the knowledge and skills needed to care for adults. Emphasis is placed on activity of daily living skills and signs and symptoms of disease. Graduates are eligible for the National Nurse Aide Assessment Program (NNAAP) certification. Supplies are required. Criminal background check, immunization records, and drug testing are required before clinical rotation. This class is offered in traditional, hybrid, and accelerated formats.
