Perspective students must attend an orientation session, provide verification of citizenship/student visa documents, identification and take a CASAS reading assessment. A textbook, cosmetology kit and uniform are required.

This course is designed to prepare the student to become a certified EKG Technician and a certified Cardiovascular Monitor Technician. Upon completion of the class, the student will be eligible for the American Society of Phlebotomy Technician's (ASPT) certification examination. A high school diploma and textbook are required.

### Massage Therapy I

This course prepares students for practice as an entry-level professional massage therapist through coursework and hands-on lab practice. Coursework includes; human anatomy & physiology, client evaluation, and massage techniques. Massage Therapy Part II is required to complete this program of study. Upon successful completion students are eligible for the NC State Board of Massage Therapy licensing exam (Mblex). Supplies, uniform and a textbook are required. A list of specific supplies will be provided during the first class meeting. Students must attend two semesters.

### Medical Math (Hybrid)

This course is designed to provide students with experience in computing mathematical problems that are common in healthcare careers like nursing, medical assisting, and pharmacy technician. Students begin with a review of basic math and progress to conversion, ratio and proportion, and equations used in healthcare. This is a two day weekly, in person, seated course. A textbook is required.

### Nurse Aide I

This course provides the knowledge and skills needed to care for adults. Emphasis is placed on activity of daily living skills and signs and symptoms of disease. Graduates are eligible for the National Nurse Aide Assessment Program (NNAAP) certification. Supplies are required. Criminal background check, immunization records, and drug testing are required before clinical rotation. This class is offered in traditional, hybrid, and accelerated formats.
