Construction Trades Essential

This program is ideal for those interested in pursuing a career in carpentry, construction, electrical, heavy equipment, HVAC, welding, or other construction and maintenance jobs. Students will learn about basic safety, construction drawings, hand and power tools, material handling, and more. The course will cover site hazards, lifesaving equipment, and health hazards in construction, and how to reference OSHA Construction Standards resources. Students will be introduced to the soft skills needed for employment in skilled trades. Successful students will earn an OSHA-30 certification, as well as a NCCER Core credential which is a prerequisite to all other National Center for Construction Education and Research (NCCER) Level 1 craft curriculum. Coursework includes; kinesiology, communication skills, pain relief and stress management massage techniques through coursework, hands-on lab experience, and public massage clinics. Upon successful completion of Massage Therapy Parts I & II students are eligible for the NC State Board of Massage Therapy licensing exam (Mblex). Supplies, uniform and a textbook are required. A list of specific supplies will be provided during the first class meeting. Students must enroll in this course after successfully completing Massage Therapy I.
