Construction & Skilled Trades

Skilled Trades Academy

This program is ideal for those interested in pursuing a career in carpentry, construction, electrical, heavy equipment, HVAC, welding, or other construction and maintenance jobs. Students will learn about basic safety, construction drawings, hand and power tools, material handling, and more. The course will cover site hazards, lifesaving equipment, and health hazards in construction, and how to reference OSHA Construction Standards resources. Students will be introduced to the soft skills needed for employment in skilled trades.

Successful students will earn an OSHA-30 certification, as well as a NCCER Core Credential which is a prerequisite to all other National Center for Construction Education and Research (NCCER) Level 1 craft curriculum. This course complements trades-related Continuing Education courses, and is a crosswalk to Building Construction Technology. A textbook is required.

Barbering IV

Topics include hair color, advanced hair cutting techniques, hair styling, shaving, skin care, retailing and preparing for a job interview. Upon completion students should be able to demonstrate an understanding of these barbering concepts and meet program completion requirements. This is a parallel course to Barbering Concepts IV-BAR-117 and Barbering Clinic BAR-118 offered in a curriculum environment. A textbook, uniform and Barbering Kit are required. Pre-requisites include: Barbering I, II, and III.

Cosmetology in Spanish I

This course allows students who speak Spanish fluently to begin working toward a certificate by gaining 422 hours of the required 1500 hours. Instruction will focus on theoretical concepts of cosmetology with hands-on experience performed on mannequins. Students will work toward a Cosmetology License with the NC State Board of Cosmetic Arts. Perspective students must attend an orientation session, provide verification of citizenship/student visa documents, identification and take a CASAS reading assessment. A textbook, cosmetology kit and uniform are required.

Cosmetology in Spanish II

This course allows students who speak Spanish fluently to continue working toward completing hours to obtain a Cosmetology License with the NC State Board of Cosmetic Arts. Students will continue a focus on theoretical concepts of cosmetology, in addition to practical performing services in the salon. Students must have completed Cosmetology in Spanish I. Textbooks, uniform and cosmetology kit required.

Cosmetology in Spanish III

This course covers comprehensive Cosmetology concepts in a simulated salon setting. Topics include safety, product knowledge, salmon management, salesmanship, skin care, electricity, wigs, thermal hair styling, lash and brow tinting, hair removal. Scalp treatments, manicuring, shampooing, hair color, design, haircutting, chemical restructuring, pressing and other related topics. Upon completion, students should be able to safely and completely demonstrate these salon services. Students will work toward a Cosmetology License with the NC State Board of Cosmetic Arts. A textbook, cosmetology kit and uniform are required. Pre-requisites: Cosmetology in Spanish I and II

Cosmetology in Spanish V

Textbooks, uniform and cosmetology kit required.

Upon successful completion of Massage Therapy Parts I & II students are eligible for the NC State Board of Massage Therapy licensing exam (Mblex). Supplies, uniform and a textbook are required. A list of specific supplies will be provided during the first class meeting. Students must enroll in this course after successfully completing Massage Therapy I.
