## Submission Guidelines

- ❏ Applicants should be members of the greater CCCC community or residents (past, present, or future) of Lee, Harnett, and Chatham counties.
- ❏ All submissions must be connected to the current theme – Time.
- ❏ No simultaneous submissions.
- ❏ Prose submissions (fiction or creative non-fiction) are limited to 1,500 words and should be typed and double spaced. No more than two works, please.
- ❏ Poetry is limited to 3 submissions, no more than 80 lines per poem.
- ❏ In the upper left-hand corner of the first page of each submission, please list your name, address, and phone number.
- ❏ Electronic submissions are required.
- ❏ Cover contest submissions must be 2-D art in a high quality digital file. Limited to 3 submissions.
- ❏ Cash prizes will be given for the best prose, poetry, and cover art.
- ❏ The deadline for submission to the 2012 themed issue is January 16, 2012. The magazine will be available Spring 2012.
