ABOUT THIS PROGRAM

The Associate in Arts program prepares students for completion of a bachelor's degree in fields as varied as business, history, psychology, English, and many more. Students who complete an AA degree will be able to transfer 60 credit hours (the equivalent of four semesters of study) to another college or university to complete their undergraduate degree. The AA may be completed through seated or online classes or a blend of both. AA students work closely with academic advisors to help them transfer to both public and private universities and colleges. Transfer within the state of North Carolina is done by way of the Comprehensive and Independent Articulation Agreements.
