

College and Career Readiness MINOR RELEASE FORM - INSTRUCTIONS

Instructions for Completing Minor Release Paperwork

The minor release paperwork must be completed for a student who is 16-17 years old prior to enrollment in the College and Career Readiness Program at Central Carolina Community College.

Minor Release Form – School: Minors withdrawn from school within a six-month period must obtain a signed official withdrawal form from the local public or private educational agency.

Minor Release Form – Parent/Guardian: Minors under the age of 18 must obtain a signed, notarized petition of a parent, legal guardian, or other person or agency having legal custody and control.

Step 1	Student completes the Student Information sections on both the School and Parent/Guardian Release Forms.
Step 2	School personnel and principal complete the School Release section of the School Release Form and affix the official school seal or place in a sealed envelope. The School Release Form can be hand delivered or mailed to the College and Career Readiness program staff listed at the bottom of the form.
	For enrollment in the Adult High School Diploma program, an official high school transcript should also be requested and submitted in a sealed envelope.
Step 3	A parent or legal guardian completes the Parent/Guardian Authorization section on the Parent Release Form. The signature must be completed in front of a notary public.
Step 4	A notary public must complete the Notary section of the Parent Release Form validating the signature of the parent/guardian.
Step 5	Submit the School and Parental Release Forms to the College and Career Readiness program staff listed at the bottom of the form. Forms may be dropped off or mailed.
Step 6	After submitting all required minor release paperwork, a student may enroll in and begin classes in the College and Career Readiness Program at Central Carolina Community College.

North Carolina Dropout Prevention Law

A minor student under the age of 18 can lose their driver's license or permit for the following reasons:

- a) Dropping out of high school
- b) Failure to make adequate progress
- c) Certain disciplinary offenses resulting in expulsion

A minor student who withdraws from high school is classified as a dropout and <u>may</u> be decertified by the public school from which they withdrew. Students may request recertification after 6 months of satisfactory attendance and progress or upon receiving a high school equivalency diploma or graduating from the Adult High School Diploma program. A certified, non-graduate student who does not maintain adequate attendance or progress while enrolled or is expelled for disciplinary reasons may be decertified and reported to the DMV by the College and Career Readiness Program.

Lose Control, Lose Your License

North Carolina's "Lose Control; Lose Your License" law denies or takes away permits or licenses of minors age 16-17 when they are suspended or expelled for three or more days due to one of the following offenses: possession of drugs or weapons on a school campus or school activity; or assault on school personnel. Students who lose licenses or permits under this law lose them for an entire year.
