Pathway Overview

- Designed to prepare individuals to work with all children from infancy through 8 years of age in diverse learning environments
- Coursework includes childhood growth and development of all young children, physical/nutritional needs of children, care and guidance of children, and communication skills with parents and children
- Students will foster the cognitive/language, physical/motor, social/emotional, and creative development of young children
- Curriculum will combine learned theories with practice in actual settings under the supervision of qualified teachers
- Credits earned in this program may be transferred toward an Associate in Applied Science Degree in Early Childhood provided the student meets the entrance requirements for the degree program
