Online Library Catalog

The CCCC Library has a new online library catalog. The catalog is available on all library computers and can also be accessed from other computers on campus and from home with Internet service. CCCC is a member of CCLINC (Community College Libraries in North Carolina). The online catalog not only shows the holdings of the CCCC libraries but the items held by over 40 other community colleges in North Carolina that are a part of CCLINC. The items at these other colleges may be requested by patrons and sent to a CCCC library for checkout. The request can be made at the circulation desk or through the online catalog. In order to make a request, a patron must have a CCCC library card and a PIN number that is assigned at the time the library card is issued.

Items requested from another CCCC library will be delivered the next day. Please allow approximately one week for items from other community college libraries.

For instruction in searching the online library catalog, please ask at the circulation desk.



Library Instruction

The goal of the library staff is to help each library user become knowledgeable, comfortable, and independent in accessing information through contemporary library technology and basic resources. To help achieve this goal, a variety of instructional classes are provided for students, faculty, and staff. The following classes can be arranged:

Library Tours provide an overview of the facility, an introduction to the online library catalog and the services provided by the library. The tour can be designed to include special emphasis on material for a course.

Workshops will give instruction in basic computer skills, information literacy fundamentals, database or World Wide Web searching. These workshops will be offered at various times during each semester or users may sign up for individual instruction.

Class Instruction can be requested by instructors. Classes may include library tours, information literacy fundamentals, general database and WWW searching, or course related instruction that focuses on resources for a particular assignment or a specific subject area.
