Database Update

New Look for the Integrated Search

Our Library Integrated Search, available on our web page at www.cccc.edu/library, has a new look and new options. The Integrated Search allows you to search NC LIVE and other library databases, including the library catalog, simultaneously in a single combined search. You can now choose which subject groups of databases to search on the main tab by choosing the subjects that best fit your topic. On the second tab, you can search by the types of resources you want to find, such as magazines, eBooks, or eVideos. You can also search all 52 databases plus the library catalog. The third tab allows you to identify the magazines, journals, and newspapers to which the library subscribes and has on the shelf. You may also search NC LIVE to locate a specific periodical title online. The fourth tab provides information about our interlibrary loan (ILL) services, and includes links to our online ILL request forms, as well as the WorldCat database for identifying other resources available for borrowing from other libraries. More information on the Integrated Search will be covered in library instruction classes, and a video tutorial will be available later in the semester. Watch for announcements!
