Central Carolina Community College's Health and Fitness Science program prepares multiskilled fitness professionals to be qualified to perform various skills in the health and fitness industry. Classes include an overview on physiology, anatomy and kinesiology as well as credentials offered in CPR, First Aid, Group Exercise, Health Coach and Personal Training. Graduates of the Health and Fitness Science program will be required to sit for the American Council on Exercise (ACE) Personal Trainer, Group Exercise, and Health Coach Certification exams before graduation. Graduates may also be eligible to sit for a variety of other examinations that pertain to the health and fitness industry.
