



VETERINARY MEDICAL TECHNOLOGY LIMITED ENROLLMENT ADMISSIONS PROCESS

Submit CCCC Admissions Application

- Submitted a **CCCC Admissions Application** within the last 12 months or be currently enrolled.

Submit ALL Transcripts

Submit **ALL** past transcripts

- High School or GED
- All Past Colleges, *even if no degree or credential was attained.*

English and Math Ready

- Students must be ready to take ENG-111 and MAT-110 without a co-requisite course.
- Students can meet this requirement by having completed past ENG and MAT courses, High School GPA of 2.6 or higher, or test scores.

Complete the Health Science Information Session

- Students are required to complete the **Health Science Information Session.**

Complete ALL General Education Courses

- The following courses are ***required to be completed with a grade of "B" or better*** prior to applying: CHM-130/130A
- The following courses are ***required to be completed with a grade of "C" or better*** prior to applying: ENG-111, ACA-122, MAT-110, Social Science Elective, Communication Elective, & a Humanities Elective.

Achieve Minimum Health Science Program GPA

- Students must have a GPA of **2.5** or higher. This is calculated based on the general education courses for the program.
- Students can apply if they have a 2.0-2.5 GPA but will be placed on an alternate list. Alternates will be considered if there are not enough applicants to fill seats.*

Complete Observation Hours (Highly Recommended)

- Students are encouraged to complete 40 observation hours in a local office or clinic. You can document your hours on the **Observation Hours Form.**
- Observation Hours are not required to apply and will not affect admissions, but are highly recommended.

Eligibility to Apply

- Once the requirements have been met, students can submit a **Limited Enrollment Application** which is linked from the **Success Hub (linked in your CCCC Portal)**
- Students are reviewed on a rolling basis and entered based on date of application.

OTHER REQUIREMENTS

Statement of Good Standing

- If students were ever dismissed or withdrawn from a previous Health Science Program, they must submit a Statement of Good Standing.

Complete TOEFL Exam

- TOEFL scores are required for any naturalized or non-US citizen with English as the second language.
- Students must submit test scores (within 5 years):
 - **TOEFL iBT Total Score - 80 or higher**
 - **TOEFL Essential Overall Band Score: 8 or higher**

Submit Proof of Rabies Vaccination (If Accepted)

- The American Veterinary Medical Association (AVMA) Committee on Veterinary Technician Education and Activities (CVTEA) requires that all students in accredited programs be vaccinated against rabies. Students will be **required** to show proof of having **two doses of the Pre-Exposure Rabies Vaccination** before the start of the program.

Meeting with Department Chair (If Accepted)

- Students are required to meet with the Department Chair for the program prior to the program start date.

Attend Program Orientation (If Accepted)

- Each student will be required to attend a **program orientation**. This usually occurs during the summer before courses start. This will provide a good overview of program requirements and assist students in preparing to start the program.
