• Submitted a <u>CCCC Admissions Application</u> within the last 12 months or be currently enrolled.

Submit ALL past transcripts

- High School or GED
- All Past Colleges, even if no degree or credential was attained.
- Nurse Aide I Transcripts
- Students must be ready to take ENG-111 and MAT-110 without a co-requisite course.
- Students can meet this requirement by having completed past ENG and MAT courses, High School GPAof 2.6 or higher, or test scores.
- Students are required to complete the **Health Science Information Session**.
- Complete the **ATI TEAS Exam** within the past three years.
- Minimum scores: Reading 58.7
- Learn about scheduling and paying for the TEAS.
- Students can take the TEAS on Harnett or Lee Campus.
- The following courses are required to be completed with a grade of "B" or better prior to applying: BIO-168 and BIO-169.
- The following courses are required to be completed with a grade of "C" or better prior to applying: ENG-111, PSY-150, & ACA-122.
- Students must have a GPA of **2.5** or higher. This is calculated based on the general education courses for the program.
- Students can apply if they have a **2.0-2.5** GPA but will be placed on an alternate list. Alternates will be considered if there are not enough applicants to fill seats.

 Students are required to complete the Nurse Aide I Course and be listed on the <u>North Carolina Nurse Aide I Registry</u> from an <u>Approved North Carolina Nurse Aide I Program</u>.

OTHER REQUIREMENTS

Eligibility to Apply

- Once the requirements have been met, students can submit a Limited Enrollment Application which is linked from the Success Hub (linked in your <u>CCCC Portal)</u>
- Students are reviewed on a rolling basis and entered based on date of application.

Statement of Good Standing

• If students were ever dismissed or withdrawn from a previous Health Science Program, they must submit a **Statement of Good Standing**.

Complete TOEFL Exam

- <u>TOEFL</u> scores are required for any naturalized or non-US citizen with English as the second language.
- Students must submit test scores (within 5 years):
 - O TOEFL iBT Total Score 80 or higher
 - TOEFL Essential Overall Band Score: 8 or higher

Submit Additional Records (If Accepted)

- Students will be assigned to clinical sites that require vaccination records. Therefore, students should submit required immunization records - MMR, TDAP, Varicella, TB Skin Test, Flu
- Complete required drug testing
- Complete background check
- Submit proof of CPR or Complete with Program (American Heart BLS)

Meeting with Department Chair (If Accepted)

 Students are required to meet with the Department Chair for the program prior to the program start date.

Attend Program Orientation (If Accepted)

 Each student will be required to attend a program orientation. This usually occurs during the summer before courses start. This will provide a good overview of program requirements and assist students in preparing to start the program.
