



## DENTAL ASSISTING LIMITED ENROLLMENT **ADMISSIONS PROCESS**

Submit CCCC Admissions Application	<ul> <li>Submitted a <u>CCCC Admissions Application</u> within the last 12 months or be currently enrolled.</li> </ul>
Submit ALL Transcripts	<ul> <li>Submit ALL past transcripts</li> <li>High School or GED</li> <li>All Past Colleges, even if no degree or credential was attained.</li> </ul>
English and Math Ready	<ul> <li>Students must be ready to take ENG-111 and MAT-110 without a co-requisite course.</li> <li>Students can meet this requirement by having completed past ENG and MAT courses, High School GPA of 2.6 or higher, or test scores.</li> </ul>
Complete the Health Science Information Session	<ul> <li>Students are required to complete the <u>Health Science Information Session.</u></li> </ul>
Complete ALL General Education Courses	<ul> <li>The following courses are <i>required to be completed with a grade of</i> "<i>B</i>" or better prior to applying: BIO-106</li> <li>The following courses are <i>required to be completed with a grade of "C</i>" or better prior to applying: ENG-111, PSY-150, &amp; ACA-122.</li> </ul>
Achieve Minimum Health Science Program GPA	<ul> <li>Students must have a GPA of 2.5 or higher. This is calculated based on the general education courses for the program.</li> <li>Students can apply if they have a 2.0-2.5 GPA but will be placed on an alternate list. Alternates will be considered if there are not enough applicants to fill seats.</li> </ul>
Eligibility to Apply	<ul> <li>Once the requirements have been met, students can submit a Limited Enrollment Application which is linked from the Success Hub (linked in your <u>CCCC Portal</u>).</li> <li>Students are reviewed on a rolling basis and entered based on date of application.</li> </ul>

## **OTHER REQUIREMENTS**

Statement of Good Standing	<ul> <li>If students were ever dismissed or withdrawn from a previous Health Science Program, they must submit a <u>Statement of Good Standing.</u></li> </ul>
Complete TOEFL Exam	<ul> <li><u>TOEFL</u> scores are required for any naturalized or non-US citizen with English as the second language.</li> <li>Students must submit test scores (within 5 years):         <ul> <li>TOEFL iBT Total Score - 80 or higher</li> <li>TOEFL Essential Overall Band Score: 8 or higher</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
Submit Additional Records (If Accepted)	<ul> <li>Students will be assigned to clinical sites that require vaccination records. Therefore, students should submit required immunization records - MMR, TDAP, Varicella, TB Skin Test, Flu</li> <li>Complete required drug testing</li> <li>Complete background check</li> <li>Submit proof of CPR or Complete with Program (American Heart - BLS)</li> </ul>
Meeting with Department Chair (If Accepted)	<ul> <li>Students are required to meet with the Department Chair for the program prior to the program start date.</li> </ul>
Attend Program Orientation (If Accepted)	<ul> <li>Each student will be required to attend a program orientation. This usually occurs during the summer before courses start. This will provide a good overview of program requirements and assist students in preparing to start the program.</li> </ul>
