Policy 6.3.7 - Historically Underutilized Business

The College affirms the State of North Carolina's commitment to encourage participation of historically underutilized businesses in the College's purchase of goods and services. The College prohibits discrimination against any person or business on the basis of race, ethnicity, religion, color, national origin, sex, gender, gender identity, sexual orientation, age, disability, genetic information, political affiliation, or status as a covered veteran in accordance with all applicable federal, state, and local laws

In alignment with North Carolina Executive Order #150, the College has adopted the verifiable percentage goal of ten percent (10%) of its total annual value of all purchases of goods and services involving participation by the following women- and minority-owned businesses:

- Minority-owned,
- Female-owned,
- Disabled-owned,
- Disabled business enterprises, or
- Non-profit work centers for the blind and severely disabled.

For construction projects, the College shall adhere to the guidelines established by the Department of Administration's Office of State Construction.
