Student Services Section *Policy 5.2.4 - Grading System*

The College follows the requirements of the North Carolina State Board of Community Colleges in awarding curriculum credit hours for instruction. The amount of credit hours awarded for each course at CCCC is determined by the North Carolina Community College System and listed in the Combined Course Library.

The College provides a uniform grade point system in curriculum areas. A cumulative grade point average is maintained that includes all courses taken.

If a course is re-taken, only the highest grade will be calculated in the grade point average; however, both grades will be recorded on the transcript. Grades of "W" are not calculated in the grade point average.
