Student Services Section *Policy 5.2.5 - Grade Appeal*

This Policy governs grade appeals unrelated to issues pertaining to the Student Code of Conduct.

Grade appeals may only be made regarding final course grades. In the event a student appeals a grade that prevents progression in a program, the student will be allowed to enroll and attend the following semester pending the outcome of the appeal. For sequential classes that have a clinical component, the student will be allowed to take the academic coursework but will not be allowed to participate in the clinical component of the class until the appeal is over. If the grade is upheld, the student will be administratively dropped from the course and refunded the tuition.
