Pre-Respiratory Therapy Program (A55280RT)

Through a partnership between Sandhills Community College and Central Carolina Community College, students complete their general education requirements at Central Carolina Community College and then transfer to Sandhills Community College to finish the Respiratory Therapy program coursework. Students will graduate with an Associate in Applied Science degree from Sandhills Community College.

The Pre-Respiratory Therapy (Pre-RT) program provides the academic preparation needed for success in the Respiratory Therapy program. Coursework in anatomy and physiology builds a strong understanding of the human body's systems, with an emphasis on the respiratory and cardiovascular systems. Chemistry coursework introduces foundational scientific principles that support understanding of gas exchange, acid-base balance, and the effects of medication, all of which are central to respiratory care. The program also emphasizes communication, critical thinking, and college readiness. Coursework in writing, communication, psychology, and the humanities strengthens professional communication, clinical reasoning, and understanding of patient behavior. College success coursework supports effective study strategies, time management, and academic confidence. Together, these courses prepare students to transition successfully into the Respiratory Therapy program and hands-on clinical training.

The Pre-RT program is a preparation pathway and does not lead to a degree. Students who decide not to pursue this profession will need to work with their Education Navigator to transition into a different degree pathway.
