SEASONS OF IPEDS

Every year, higher education institutions across the country must submit data to the National Center for Education Statistics (NCES). The system by which the NCES collects this information is called the [Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System](#) (IPEDS). As a college that awards federal student financial aid, Central Carolina Community College participates in IPEDS reporting. The data collection cycle takes place in three stages.




